Valve Cover Racer Rules:

Always a crowd favorite, the IEC Valve Cover Race will be held during the Friday Night Hospitality Social. Everyone is encouraged to participate and you do not need a drivers license to race!

Official rules for design of the valve cover racer are as follows:

- You must use an actual valve cover from an automobile engine – any make (not just an Edsel).
- No engine, propulsion or moving weights are allowed.
- Nothing can extend beyond the front of the valve cover.
- Maximum weight cannot exceed 10 pounds.
- Maximum length cannot exceed 30 inches.
- Maximum width cannot exceed 12 inches.
- Maximum height cannot exceed 10 inches.
- Valve cover must have 4 wheels; the diameter of each wheel cannot exceed 6 inches
- The wheels must have a non metallic surface that contacts the track.
- Wheels can be attached in any manner – inside or outside, BUT not beyond the front of the valve cover.

Note: There will be an “Outlaw Division” especially for valve cover racers that do not meet the above restrictions. So, bring what you’ve got and we’ll have fun!
